Thanks to this program, young filmmakers benefit from support adapted to their project and their level of professional experience, and participate during their stay in Cannes in workshops. intensive masterclasses. training sessions according to their needs (rewriting, coproduction, distribution, etc.), targeted meetings with professionals likely to co-finance their project, etc.




SOUTH AFRICA SANDA


CAPE VERDE PATRICIA SILVA

Her first documentary film "Sur les traces de mes ancêtres" won the award for best national documentary and the UEMOA award for best integration film at the Clap Ivoire 2022 Festival as well as the 2nd best African film school award at FESPACO.


BENIN — MOUHAMED ALLABI

EGYPT KAWTAR YOUNIS


Kawthar Younis is an Egyptian director and cofounder of Rawiyat-Sisters in Film, a collective of women filmmakers from the Arab world. Kawthar also produces feature films, short films and mini-series through her production company KINO. In 2015, she directed "A Present from the Past", her graduation project at the Cairo Higher Institute of Cinema.

Her film "Sahbety" ("My girl friend") won the Special Jury Prize for Best Short Film at the Cairo International Film Festival in 2022. It is the first Egyptian short film to be entered in the Venice Film Festival.


AMINA ABDOULAYE MAMANI

After three years of study in audiovisual production at the Institut de Formation aux Techniques de l'Information et de la Communication (IFTIC) in Niamey, where she directed her graduation documentary, "Le Hawan idi", she won the prize for the best school documentary film at the FESPACO 2013.

Winner of the Fonds pour la jeune création francophone (JCF) and the DEENTAL-ACP bonus, her film "L'envoyée de Dieu" received the UEMOA Special Prize for short fiction at the 28th edition of FESPACO 2023.

CAMEROON (* **LIONEL META**

Born in Clermont-Ferrand, Cameroonian director Lionel Meta first studied philosophy and then worked on music videos and TV films. A graduate of the University of Paris X-Nanterre, he directed his first short film in 2019 entitled "Je me marierai avec mon père". In 2010, his second self-produced film, "La Métaphore du manioc", received the Défi jeune award and the best screenplay award at the Lille **European Film Festival.**

"Mariam" is his first produced short film. It received the Best Actress Award at the Dakar Court Festival 2022 and the Best Short Film Award at the Burundi International Film and Audiovisual Festival (FESTICAB 2022).

THE FESTIVALS



CLAP IVOIRE

Launched in 2004, CLAP IVOIRE is a competition festival of short video films by young technicians and directors from the eight member countries of the West African Economic and Monetary Union, organized by the National Film Office of Côte d'Ivoire. The competition concerns the short fiction category and the documentary category, lasting 13 minutes. The 21st edition of Clap Ivoire was held in Abidjan from September 5 to 9, 2022.



ECRANS NOIRS

Founded in 1997 by director Bassek Ba Kobhio, the festival is held every year in Yaoundé, Cameroon. Organized by the association Ecrans noirs, its objective is to broadcast cinematographic creations from six Central African countries: Cameroon, Gabon, Congo, Democratic Republic of Congo, Central African Republic and Chad. Ecrans noirs celebrated its 26th edition from October 1 to 8, 2022.



DAKAR COURT

Created in December 2018, the DAKAR COURT festival is co-organized by the CINEMAREKK association, which federates film clubs at the national and sub-regional level, and the French Institute of Dakar. Each year, the Festival organizes the training of a dozen young filmmakers as part of its Talents Dakar Court system. The last edition of Dakar Court was held from December 5 to 10, 2022.



FESPACO

The Ouagadougou Pan-African Film and Television Festival is one of the biggest African film festivals. Created in 1969, it takes place every two years in the capital of Burkina Faso. Its International Market for African Cinema and Television (Mica) has since 2021 included a professional component which is divided into two types of workshops: the Yennenga post-production and the Yennenga Academy. The 28th edition of FESPACO was held from February 25 to March 4, 2023.

THE FESTIVALS



FESTICAB

The International Film and Audiovisual Festival of Burundi was created in 2009 to promote the Film Industry of Burundi. Its vocation is to encourage the diversity of African cinema, with an emphasis on local and East African productions. The 13th edition of FESTICAB was held in Bujumbura from May 27 to June 3, 2022.



CAIRO INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

Organized since 1985 under the auspices of the Egyptian Ministry of Culture, the Cairo International Film Festival is the most prestigious film event in Egypt and one of the most important in the Middle East. It also organizes the Cairo Film Connection, a co-production platform. The 44th edition of the Festival was held from November 13 to 22, 2022.



SAO TOME INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

Created in 2014, the São Tomé FestFilm aims to develop projects in the fields of cinema, television and multimedia through the offer of educational activities such as workshops and conferences. The Festival promotes the historical and cultural origins of São Tomé and Principe through cinema and the Portuguese language. The 5th edition took place from October 26 to 29, 2022.



THE PITCH SOUTH AFRICA

The Pitch South Africa is a competition launched in 2019. Throughout the process, candidates meet professionals who give them advice to take their skills to the next level. The winner receives professional production support worth R300,000.
